## Weekly Highlights

### Marciniszyn leads the pack:



Mike Marciniszyn had the first eleven strikes in his last game of the day. He set himself on the approach for his final shot and with the adrenalin flowing, he delivered the ball down the lane in anticipation of recording his 11<sup>th</sup> perfect game (3 in the USA). However, that was not to happen, as he came a bit light on the head pin leaving the 2-5 pins. He was bowling in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 27 & 28 at Marcin Bowl, finishing the day with 765 (256-211-298 – 76 pins over average ) to record both the high single and triple of the week in

Lambton County Tenpin Association (LCTA) bowling competition. It was his 4<sup>th</sup> 700 of the season in the LCTA as he previously bowled 709, 788 and 714. Marciniszyn is averaging 224 for 51 games in the BWCL this year bowling with teammates George Newman and Peter English. Last year in the league he averaged 213 for 99 games.

### Shephard maintains his lead:

Mike Shephard hurled 762 (278 – 50 pins over average – 236-248) in the Bar10 Thursday Night Mixed League (B10TNML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl, to register the 2<sup>nd</sup> high triple of the week and his 22<sup>nd</sup> 700 in the LCTA this season. Shephard maintains his lead over Ben Lapointe by four in the season's crown race as Lapointe also notched a 700 this past week. Mike is having a solid year in the Bar10 TNML this season as he has posted 7-700's in the league (804-



745-754-718-703-726-762) this season. He is now averaging 228 after 18 weeks in the league.

## *Bonhomme fires career high scores:*



Rob Bonhomme wheeled 685 (178- 270 – 96 pins over average - 237 – 163 pins over average for three games) in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl to register new personal high scores. His previous high scores were 659 (185-235-239) which he bowled in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League last season and 269. Bonhomme is averaging 178 for 48 games in the MFFL this year bowling with teammates Abby Daamen, Makayla Apter and Brian Daamen. Last year in the league he averaged 167 for 93 games.

## *Lucas bowls career high single:*



Jason Lucas fired 266 (99 pins over average) in his first game of the night to record a new personal high single topping his previous 263. He was bowling in the Sarnia Produce Border City Men’s League (SPBCML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl. Jason’s career high triple is 670 (263-193-214) which he recorded in the SPBCML in the 2022-2023 season. Lucas is averaging 169 for 54 games in the SPBCML this year bowling on the “Lambton Metal Services” team with Franco Gabriele, Franco Savo and Ben Lapointe. Last year in the league he averaged 167 for 96 games.

## *Pimentel tops his high single:*

Dan Pimental rolled 242 (84 pins over average) in his last game of the night to top his previous high of 239. He was bowling in the Mulder Financial Fun League (MFFL) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl finishing with a 580 triple. His career high triple is 616 (210-201-205) which he recorded in the MFFL in the 2022-2023 season. Pimentel is averaging 160 for 51 games in the MFFL this year



bowling with teammates Aaron Crabtree, Tim Nickels, Ryan Webb and TJ Kinny. Last year in the league he averaged 154 for 66 games.

### Youth records career high single:

Youth bowler Evan Peters rolled 127 (72 pins over average) ) in his last game of the day in the Phantom Youth League on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl. This writer is not sure of Evan's highest game but as a new bowler with a 55 average I would say this has to be his highest single game. He finished the day with a 274 triple (109 pins over average), so this is probably his highest triple. CONGRATULATIONS Evan on your great bowling.

### Chipman takes third place:



Shane Chipman tossed 748 (234-246-268 – 57 pins over average) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 29 & 30 at Marcin Bowl to post the 3<sup>rd</sup> high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 7<sup>th</sup> 700 this season as he previously bowled 722, 729, 736, 704, 761 and 703. Chipman is averaging 213 for 51 games in the BWCL this year bowling with teammates Jason Armitage and Bryce Watson. Last year in the league he averaged 207 for 93 games.

### 7-10 spit conversion:

Congratulations goes to Andrew McLean for converting the 7-10 split. Andrew was bowling in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League on lane 29 when he fired the ball at 19 MPH at the 10 pin. The 10-pin bounced off the back skirt and took out the 7 pin. This is a very difficult spare to convert as the conversion rate is 0.7% but Jay Smith and Jason Armitage have also made the conversion this season. This is unusual because you might get one conversion every one or two years at best.





**Murphy records number two:**

Chris Murphy bowled 718 (236-215-267 – 67 pins over average – 118 pins over average for three games) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 19 & 20 at Marcin Bowl to register the 4<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his 2<sup>nd</sup> 700 of the season as he previously tossed 725 (235-245-245). Chris is averaging 202 for 48 games in the FTBMNML this year bowling on the “Murphy’s Law” team with teammates Dan Beauvais, Brett Zevenbergen and Jay Smith. Last year in the league he averaged 198 for 85 games.

**Adamson rolls another solid triple:**

Kyle Adamson fired 715 (225-255-235) in the Best Wiring Classic League (BWCL) on lanes 35 & 36 at Marcin Bowl to grab the 5<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week in the LCTA. It was his second consecutive 700 in the league as last week he bowled 705 (202-247-256). It was his 5<sup>th</sup> 700 of the season. Paul hurled 711 (198-257-256 ) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men’s League (FTBMNML) on lanes 31 & 32 at Marcin Bowl to share the 6<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week with brother Roy. It was his 2<sup>nd</sup> 700 this season as he previously bowled 799 (266-267-266) in the FTBMNML. ### *Lapointe Junior remains four back:*

Ben Lapointe tossed 708 (234-268-206) in the Fabbri Tile Bluewater Monday Night Men's League (FTBMNML) on lanes 15 & 16 at Marcin Bowl to record the 8<sup>th</sup> high triple of the week. It was his 18<sup>th</sup> 700 in the LCTA this season and his career 132<sup>nd</sup> 700. **Ridealgh rolls number three:**

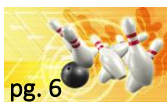

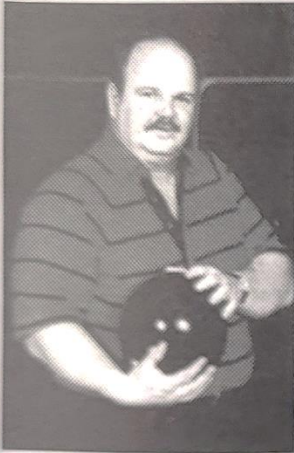

**JIM BOURGEOIS – Born: Glace Bay, N.S.**



1973-1974--Jim started bowling in the Sarnia and District 10 Pin Assoc. and the Port Huron Bowling League.

1983-1984-- High Single in Sarnia 299.

1981-1988 -- Sarnia Bowling League High Average 209. High Single Game 298 and High Triple 735.

1988-1989-- Jim bowled a perfect 300 game in Ontario Provincials, the first person to do so.

1990-1991-- Jim set a Provincial Record of 834 for a 3 game series.

1993-1994 -- Sarnia Doubles Tournament 1401 (tie).

1995-1996 -- Bowled 298, 299, 300 games.

1996-1997 -- Single Game 299 High Triple 797.

1998-1999 -- Single Game 300 High Triple 802.

1999-2000 -- Single Game 299.

2001 -- Single Game 300.

From 1984-2001 -- Jim had 15-300 games, 5-299 games, 1-298 game, 8-800 3 game series and 14-700 3 game series all sanctioned by the American Bowling Congress.

From 1973-2001 -- In all his bowling, Jim bowled 28 perfect 300 games and 8-800 3
